None appeared on behalf of the public body. The response submitted by the public body was shared with the applicant, who has submitted rejoinder, which was sent to the public body for response. The Commission has examined the information request, the response of the public body, and the rejoinder of the applicant. The information request basically relates to the submission of CNIC copy while sending letters to government officials, ministries, or commissions. The public body has categorically responded that this is being done as part of instructions in view of the law and order situation in Balochistan.

2. The examination of the file leads us to the conclusion that the response of the public body is categorical and based on the security situation. The Commission cannot interfere in the working of the public bodies, and the information in response to the applicant's request has been provided, which serves the purpose. He may like to take it up with the relevant organization/ministry, if he so desires, for change in their policy. No further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
