June 04, 2026 Muhammad Sohail, Assistant Director, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body, vide letter dated 27-04-2026, furnished a written reply stating that the judgment of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan concerned the protection of the rights of civil servants and employees. The legitimacy of the Cabinet Sub-Committee on Regulations of Employees is currently sub judice before the Islamabad High Court, which has granted stay in favour of the employees. Consequently, the Office Memorandum issued by the Establishment Division was suspended until the completion of the proceedings before the Islamabad High Court. Copies of the judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan passed in Civil Petitions Nos. 949, 1025, 1028, and 1132 to 1134 of 2023, as well as copy of the order of the Islamabad High Court passed in Writ Petition No. 3758/2025, were also annexed with the written reply.

2. The Commission shared copy of the written reply with the applicant, who filed rejoinder stating that the Ministry's reply invoking judicial restraint and the pendency of proceedings was misconceived. The Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 does not recognize sub judice as a blanket exemption. The Commission has examined the contents of the information request, the written reply furnished by the public body, the rejoinder filed by the applicant, and the relevant law on the subject. In the information request and appeal, the applicant has raised certain questions/queries from the public body regarding compliance with the judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan passed in the above-mentioned civil petitions, whereby the Supreme Court interpreted the Civil Servants Act, 1973, and the Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1977.

3. After the passing of the above-mentioned judgment, Dr. Iram Naveed and others filed writ petition before the Islamabad High Court, and the Islamabad High Court, vide order dated 17-09-2025, suspended Notification dated 03-07-2025.

4. The cumulative effect of both judgments is that, until the decision of the writ petition pending before the Islamabad High Court, the queries of the applicant regarding the implementation of the judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan cannot be answered.

5. In view of the above, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.

1. The information provided by the public body was shared with the applicant vide letter dated 05-05-2026 under RGL No. 170313796. The applicant has submitted a rejoinder containing another information request. The representative of the public body has been heard. The response has been perused along with the rejoinder submitted by the applicant. The matter has been considered in the light of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017. The Commission observes that the information sought by the applicant through his information request relates to other persons, which is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017. In the rejoinder, the applicant has raised additional questions which are beyond the scope of his original information request. The response of the public body addresses all the queries contained in the information request.

2. In view of this analysis, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
