None appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The applicant vide his information request dated 26-08-2025 has required following information from CEO, IHRA;
2. Allegedly the said information was not provided to the applicant within the stipulate time period hence he filed this appeal before the Commission. In response to the notices issued by the Commission, the public body has filed written reply taking plea that

1. A copy of the appointment notification of Dr. Syed Ahmed Raza Kazmi as Chief Executive Officer of the Authority;

2. A copy of the advertisement or public notice pursuant to which the existing Chief Executive Officer applied for the position;

3. The names of the other two shortlisted candidates for the post of Chief Executive Officer, alongside Dr. Syed Ahmed Raza Kazmi, indicating their position in the merit list;

4. A copy of any correspondence issued to an intelligence agency for the purpose of conducting a security clearance or background check of the shortlisted candidates;

5. A copy of any response received from the intelligence agency regarding the security clearance or background check of the shortlisted candidates;

6. A copy of the relevant provision of the Islamabad Healthcare Regulation Act, 2018, the rules or regulations framed thereunder, or any other document that prescribes that the appointment of the Chief Executive Officer shall be finalized on the recommendation of an intelligence agency;

7. A copy of the minutes of the meeting in which the appointment of Dr. Syed Ahmed Raza Kazmi as Chief Executive Officer was finalized;

8. The details of all perks, privileges, allowances, and other entitlements of the Chief Executive Officer of the IHRA, along with the rules or policy basis under which these are granted.

3. Copy of the written reply was shared with the applicant vide notice dated 09-12-2025 under RGL No. 154263806, and no response has been received from the applicant. However, it is noted that the plea of the public body taken in the written reply requires adjudication.
4. The Commission has perused the information request, memo of the appeal, and written reply furnished by the public body and found that, except for the information required at Serial No. 4 and 5 of the information request, which pertains to the correspondence between the public body and security agencies, the remaining information is public record. The information cited at Serial No. 4 and 5 comes within the purview of the personal privacy of an individual and is exempted from disclosure under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
5. In view of above, the appeal is partially allowed. CEO, IHRA, is directed to furnish certified copies of the information cited at Serial No. 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, and 8 of the information request within 10 days; however, the information cited at Serial No. 4 and 5 is declined. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.

Ms. Mehraj Tareen Advocate appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. Reply of the public body was furnished and shared with the applicant, who has filed rejoinder stating that since March 2024, the CDA Security Directorate has done nothing to trace the missing files, and he does not see any hope in the next 10 years; hence, he wants to withdraw his appeal. Although the applicant, in his rejoinder, has shown his grievance that he is not hopeful of the public body, the CDA has categorically stated in its reply that the matter of double allotment is under litigation with the Civil Court, and the IHC has also restrained the CDA from taking further steps to transfer the plot to any party.
2. So, until and unless the matter is decided by the Civil Court, the CDA cannot take any further step. Further, the applicant in his rejoinder also wishes to withdraw this appeal; therefore, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn.
