The public body furnished written reply and in para 4 of the same informed that except information cited at serial no. 2 of the information request, remaining is available on the website of the public body. Link of the website has also been mentioned in the written reply. As far as information required at serial no. 2 of the information request is concerned, it was submitted that said information cannot be disclosed as it enjoys exemption under Section 16(b), (d), (e), and (g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
2. The commission shared copy of the written reply to the appellant but it was received undelivered with the remarks that the appellant is not reachable on the given address despite repeated attempts. Whereupon the commission directed the staff to contact the appellant on cell number mentioned on the appeal i.e. 0305-3252323 and it was reported that call is not received.
3. As far as plea of Section 16(b), (d), (e), and (g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 is concerned, the Commission has noticed that the information cited at serial no. 2 of the information request, which is about the location of oil fields, cannot be disclosed as it is likely to cause serious prejudice to the security of Pakistan being a sensitive matter. In view of the above, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.

1. As per directions of the commission, the public body furnished written reply vide letter dated 16-04-2025 answering all the queries of the appellant. Said reply was shared with the appellant who has acknowledged its receipt, however has filed rejoinder showing dissatisfaction over the shared information.
2. The commission has examined the information request, reply of the public body furnished on 16-04-2025 and rejoinder of the appellant.
3. The appellant vide his information request has required detail of installed 50KV, 100KV, 150KVA and 200KVA transformers and detail of connections according to SOP in respect of Farid Town Jhangi Syedan, Islamabad Home Phase II Jhangi Syedan, Model Valley Jhangi Syedan, Tayyab Town / Tayyab Garden Phase 1 Jhangi Syedan, Tayyab Garden Phase II Jhangi Syedan, Gulshan-e-Taleem Jhangi Syedan and Shams Town Jhangi Syedan.
4. The public body in the written reply dated 16-04-2025 has furnished detail of installation of the said transformers and has categorically stated that all the transformers are installed as per SOP. It is further added that complainant is residing in Tayyab Garden Phase 1 and is involved in theft of electricity and FIR has been lodged against him for theft of the electricity. The appellant was also found selling electricity after committing theft thereof to various residents by providing sub meter and electricity. Reference of FIR 487/24 is also mentioned and trial of the said case is in process.
5. The rejoinder of the appellant over the shared information has been found not tenable as the written reply containing categorical reply of all the queries has been found adequate. Therefore, after sharing the information according to the information request, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
