1. The written reply of the rejoinder has been furnished by the public body, and the response is the same as earlier submitted by NAB on 22-07-2025. The Commission has examined the information request, the written reply furnished by the public body, the rejoinder of the applicant, and the reply thereto. It is noted that a categorical reply to Query No. 1 and 2 has been given by NAB, stating that there is no category of High Profile Reference in the NAB Ordinance, and this answer is appropriate. Query No. 3 has also been addressed, stating that a total of 8 cases were withdrawn by NAB under Section 31-B of NAO 1999.

2. Information in respect of Query No. 4 of the information request has also been rightly answered, mentioning that the said information is available on the website of NAB. Similarly, the answers to Query No. 5 and 6 are also found adequate.

3. Although the applicant, vide his rejoinder dated 07-08-2025, has stated that the public body has misinterpreted the term "High Profile Reference" and has denied the information on technical grounds, the said objection has been found without any substance.

4. The information furnished by the public body already stands shared with the applicant. No further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
