Mehboob Talib, Deputy Manager (Legal), FESCO appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body provided response to the information request of the applicant, which was shared with the applicant vide letter dated 18-12-2025 under RGL No. 154833345. The applicant has sent rejoinders dated 07-01-2026 and 06-02-2026 stating that the public body is avoiding providing the required information. Accordingly, an objective comparison of the information request, the response of the public body, and the rejoinder has been conducted by the Commission, and it has been observed as follows after hearing the representative of the public body:
 - (i). The public body will provide the complete government audit report upon payment of fee as per the regulations of the Commission, which state that the first 20 pages will not be charged, whereas additional copies will be charged at the rate of Rs. 7 per page.
 - (ii). The representative of the public body will provide the actual amount to be paid, along with the relevant head of account, to the applicant as well as to the Commission within a period of 15 days, whereupon the information will be provided to the applicant through the Commission.
 - (ii., iii., iv.) The representative of the public body states that these are part of the WAPDA E&D Rules and are available on the website at www.fesco.com.pk.
2. In view of this categorical position, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
3. Adjourned to 06-04-2026 for implementation report at Camp Office, Lahore.
