A. APPEAL

1. Mr. Syed Ibrar Hussain Shah filed his appeal before Pakistan Commission on Access to Information, Islamabad. It is alleged therein that he has not been responded by Postal Training Centre on his application under article 19A of Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan read with the Right of Access to the Information Act, 2017, wherein he has sought the camera recording of the office of the Principal, Postal Training Centre, Islamabad dated 9th July, 2021 during which he was interrogated by Miss Anam Ayaz.
2. The respondent filed a detailed reply before the Commission, the relevant part is reproduced as under:

“That there is no denial to the fact that on 09 July 2021, AD PLI M/S Anam Ayaz visited this office viz Postal Training Centre Islamabad and come across to the appellant however, there is no CCTV installed inside the office of Principle PTC, Islamabad, and the arguments / discussion made in Principal’s office is subject of an inquiry. The CCTV record/information may contain only visual and the same is not substantial in nature as a perhaps only exhibit, has it been available, arrival and departure of the officer/staff concerned. It is pointed out that CCTV backup is maintained for only 5 days and no such data is available by now.”

3. The appellant feeling dissatisfied with the response filed the rejoinder but has failed to point out anything material. The Commission is of

the considered view that the reply submitted by the respondent public body is comprehensive and self-explanatory.

D. ORDER

4. The appeal is disposed of.
