Date: May 14, 2026 No one appeared on behalf of the public body. The Commission observed that two notices had been issued to the President, National Bank of Pakistan under registered cover. The notice dated May 04, 2026 clearly stated that failure to attend the hearing would result in ex parte proceedings.

2. The Commission further observed that the matter relates to the pension of the applicant, which is accorded high priority by all forums. During the course of proceedings, Mr. Asif Iftikhar Khawaja, Manager Legal, APP, with the permission of the Commission, stood up and submitted that the applicant is an employee of their organization and that his pension for November 2025 had already been disbursed. He further stated that the delay of one day occurred due to a computer error and that the amount was subsequently paid by his organization through cheque. In support thereof, he attached a copy of the payment record while appearing on behalf of his department in another matter relating to the same issue before the Commission.
3. In view of the facts stated above, the issue stands resolved. Therefore, no further proceedings are required. Accordingly, the appeal stands disposed of. Copy of this order be sent to both the parties.
