Farrukh Habib, Inspector (Legal), Islamabad Police appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The appellant required following information from the public body;
  1. Amount spent on the purchase of tear gases from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup).
  2. Total number of the tear gas shells purchased from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup).
  3. Total number of tear gas shells used from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup)
  4. Total number of the tear gas shells are currently in stock.
  5. Amount spent on the purchase of rubber bullets from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup).
  6. Total number of rubber bullets purchased from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup)
  7. Total number of rubber bullets used from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup)
  8. Total number of the rubber bullets are currently in stock.
  9. Total amount paid to the owners of the containers and trucks from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup).
  10. Total amount spent on the purchase of lunch/food for police officials performing duties in the field from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup).
  11. List of the restaurants from where these food /lunches are purchased along with the quantity from Nov 01, 2024 to date. (Year wise breakup).
2. Required information was not provided to her, hence she filed an appeal before the Commission. After issuance of notice to the public body, it furnished written reply dated 04-03-2025, stating that contractors/vendors provide services/equipment to the ICT Police for security purposes to protect the lives and property of citizens of Islamabad and diplomats living in the Islamabad Capital. Hence, provision/disclosure of information will affect

security measures taken by ICT Police. The requisite data/information is considered exempted information and may not be disclosed, as it is covered under Section 16(c)(ii) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.

3. The Commission shared the said reply with the appellant vide letter dated 04-03-2025, but no response has been received from the appellant. However, the Commission has also examined the stance of the public body and the relevant law on the subject. The information/data required from the Islamabad Police pertains to ammunition—its purchase, use, and stock. It is a fact that the information required by the appellant, if disclosed, is likely to cause serious prejudice to the capability and effectiveness of the law enforcement agency (the public body), being a sensitive matter and a matter of security. Hence, the required information is exempted from disclosure under Section 16(b)(ii) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017; therefore, it cannot be provided. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
