1. Information furnished by the public body was shared with the applicant vide letter dated 17-12-2026 under RGL No. 154833154.
2. Today, the public body vide letter dated 15-12-2025 furnished written reply and documents pertaining to the Establishment Division and further stated that the information request in Query No. 1, 3 and 4 does not pertain to the public body and can be obtained from the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. Copy of the written reply and documents furnished by the public body were shared with the applicant, who acknowledged its receipt but filed a detailed rejoinder stating that he has not been provided the required information.
3. Applicant present in person. Muhammad Mehmood Khan, LDC, FST appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body, on receiving notice on the appeal, furnished written reply vide letter dated Nil along with certified copies to the applicant. In the said written reply, Para-1 of the information request was admitted, whereas the public body did not respond to the remaining queries. The applicant, after receiving the said written reply, has filed rejoinder, and the public body today has filed reply to the rejoinder of the applicant.
2. The applicant has submitted that query No. (b), (d) and (f) of the information request stand addressed, whereas remaining queries are still not replied.
3. The Commission has noted that query No. (a), (c), (e), (g) to (j) are in respect of the procedure or hearing of the FST, and the Registrar Office can file reply of the said queries after consultation with the Chairman or the Members of the FST. Mere saying that the said queries are pertaining to the Tribunal and the Registrar Office cannot reply to the said queries is not acceptable. Therefore, the appeal is allowed. The Registrar, FST is directed to furnish adequate replies to the remaining queries as mentioned above to the applicant as well as to this Commission within 10 days.
