1. As far as certified copies of the salary slips are concerned, the learned counsel for the public body has furnished the said information except the copy of the salary slip for March 2024. Similarly, the information required at Serial No. 3 of the information request, which is the experience letter, has not been provided. However, the learned counsel for the respondent, after seeking instructions from the concerned public body, has made statement that the copy of the salary slip for the month of March 2024 will be provided within 10 days.
2. Whereas, as per the policy of the public body, an experience certificate is not issued to employees dismissed from service on the allegation of leaking papers to students and harassing female students.
3. In view of the above, when all the required information has been furnished except the salary slip for March 2024, no further proceedings are required. The public body shall provide a copy of the salary slip for the month of March 2024 within 10 days. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.

Zofishan Manzoor, Deputy Director, MLC Department, Rana Sajjad, Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Defence appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. Written reply of rejoinder has been furnished by the p b. along with copies of the contracts / agreements in respect of engaging private security for providing services of security guard. It has been explained in the reply that duty of one security guard is not 12 hours, instead 8 hours however where there is extra/extended time for duty, the payment is also according to the duty time, contract agreement for 8 hours duty and more than 8 hours duty and more than 8 hours are annexed with reply. It is further added that disbursement of wages is the responsibility of service provided (Guard Company) as the company submits the consolidated invoice to the company.
2. As far as query 4 is concerned it is submitted that the registration with EOBI of Pvt security guard is the responsibility of relevant security company and not the CBs, as the company concerned is employer of the Pvt security guard. As far as registration of sanitary workers with EOBI is concerned, the sanitary workers are dailh wagher employees / contingency employees. They do not perform their duties on regular basis. Therefore, they are not required to be registered with EOBI.
3. The Commission has examined the queries and the answers given by the public body and the copy of the contracts attached by the public body, and found that the answers given by the public body address the information request. Let copy of the reply of the rejoinder of the public body be shared with the appellant. No further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
