1. This appeal was filed by the applicant on 02-09-2024 on the basis of the information request filed before the Secretary, Ministry of Defence on July 27, 2024, which remains un-responded to. Hence, the appeal.
2. Notices were issued to the Secretary, Ministry of Defence under RGL covers from time to time regarding the appearance of his representative and the presentation of information in accordance with law. Number of hearings have been held in this regard, and about 10 opportunities were provided to the representative of the Secretary, Ministry of Defence, on his request, to provide the relevant information. However, the information has not been provided to date. The representative of the public body has stated that they are the administrative head of the organization about whom the information has been sought. He has been stating that the required information has been sought from the concerned organizations, which has not been provided to date to the Ministry of Defence. Today, for the first time, in writing, the public body has submitted, vide letter dated 17-12-2025, that the required information has not yet been received from the concerned quarters and the same will be submitted upon receipt. This means, in categorical terms, that the public body is waiting for the supply of information from the concerned quarters and has also committed to submit that information before this

Commission under the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.  
The applicant and the public body, so far during the hearings, have been accommodating as far as adjournments are concerned, and today again the applicant agrees to a further adjournment. Copy of the proceedings be sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Defence.

Ammad Afzal Mir, Director (FAO), Zafar Iqbal Saddiqui, Audit Officer, Muhammad Ameer, Audit Officer, AGP appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. Information provided by the public body in response to the information request of the applicant was sent to him under notice dated 26-11-2025 under RGL No. 154263497. The applicant has sent rejoinder dated 13-11-2025 stating that he asked for the audit reports and not for paras only. He has further stated that the reply of the public body is silent regarding the audits conducted by the AGPR. The representative of the public body has been heard; the information request and the response of the public body have been perused. The representative of the public body makes categorical statement, in accordance with the response submitted by them pertaining to item No. 1 of the information request, that the audit of the Academy of Letters was carried out during the last five years; however, the report was not finalized as no material irregularity fit for printing in the audit report was found. According to him, the Auditor General's office does not share reports which are not printed, as these are considered to be in transitory stage with the status of under finalization.
2. As far as item No. 2 of the information request pertaining to certified copies of the audit paras by the Auditor General relating to the affairs of the Academy of Letters for the last five years is concerned, the public body representative repeats the same stance as mentioned in para-1.
3. The third item of the information request pertains to a citizen participatory audit, for which the applicant has requested information regarding selection, nomination, and confirmation for the selection of the awards; the senior representative of the public body categorically states that no such audit has been carried out by the public body so far.
4. In view of the above-mentioned position, it is clear that categorical answers to the queries of the applicant have been

provided and there is no record pending that has to be provided to the applicant, accordingly the appeal is finalized and disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
