2. The appellant has sent a rejoinder stating that the relevant law has not been provided. The information request, response of the public body, and rejoinder of the appellant have been perused. Contention of the representative of the public body has been heard, who has stated that all action was taken on the basis of these circulars, which have been provided to the appellant. Circular dated 17-12-2018 clearly states that the competent authority has the power to freeze annual increment/annual merit increase due on 01-01-2019 onwards in respect of all delinquent employees, besides suspending payment of all monetary benefits, loans and advances, and other admissible financial benefits.
3. In view of the position stated above, the information request of the appellant is duly answered. No further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
