Imran Ahmed, Superintendent, National Council for Homeopathy appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body vide letter dated 29-01-2025 furnished a written reply, submitting that the appellant has alleged in his application that the public body has altered the official record of one Omer Hayat, son of Rehmat Khan, by tampering with and modifying the examination register of Punjab Serhad Homeopathic Medical College, Bakkhar, for the period of 2004-2008, and has further sought copies of the examination registers of the said college for the aforesaid period.
2. It is the plea of the public body that the said record pertains to the personal privacy of an individual and is exempted from disclosure under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, read with Regulation No. 10 of the Homeopathic Examination Regulations, 1976. Therefore, it was submitted that the said record cannot be disclosed.
3. The response of the public body was shared with the appellant vide letter dated 13-3-25, but no response has been received from the appellant.
4. The Commission has also examined the information request and the written reply and has come to the conclusion that the record required not only falls under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, but is also exempted under Section 16(i)(iv) of the Act, as its disclosure is likely to undermine the effectiveness of the testing procedure used by the public body. In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.

None appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body vide letters dated 18-02-2025 and 13-02-2025 has informed that only 5 acres of land is under old residential encroachment, and the rest of the cultivable land is on agricultural lease as per policy. The details of the same were attached as an annexure, and it was submitted that the remaining land is cultivable and under agricultural lease according to policy. A detailed list of the encroachers has also been annexed.
2. The appellant, vide his email dated 7-3-25, submitted that Pakistan Railways, through the aforementioned letters, acknowledged the illegal occupation of 5 acres of land and provided a list of 91 occupants. However, critical information was withheld, including findings of the inquiry, identities of officials investigated, disciplinary/legal actions taken, and measures to reclaim the land and demolish structures. The Commission has examined the written reply and compared it with the information request. As far as the 5-acre land under encroachment is concerned, its details have been provided in the list of encroachers. It has also been categorically explained that no area other than the aforementioned 5 acres is encroached, and the remaining area is under agricultural lease as per policy.
3. As far as the inquiry about encroachment is concerned, from the contents of the written reply, it is found that there is no mention of any inquiry regarding any official; therefore, no question arises regarding the sharing of the same. Hence, it cannot be provided to the appellant. No further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
