1. The applicant has sent an application for review of the order of the Commission dated 28-01-2025 in Appeal No. 3480-02/24 on the following grounds:

(i) The Commission has disposed of the appeal through a brief, non-speaking order which neither (i) identifies the precise information sought, (ii) records the ECP's stance/exemptions (if any), nor (iii) addresses the Applicant's rejoinder and specific objections placed on record despite repeated requests for an order meeting these minimum requirements of reasoned decision-making.

ii. The applicant has sought recall/review of the said order and adjudication through a reasoned, speaking order or, in the alternative, demand for de-novo consideration with appropriate directions to the ECP.

2. The Commission has examined the entire file along with the application for review and provisions of the Act. The Commission is of the considered opinion that the order passed in Appeal No. 3480-02/24 on 28-01-2025 is a well-reasoned order and the documents mentioned in the order form its part. There is no reasonable ground for review/recall of that order. The applicant may like to pursue the matter at the appropriate legal forum as the Commission is bound to decide the appeals in accordance with the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
