Manzoor Hussain Advocate appeared on behalf of the public body and filed fresh power of attorney along with written reply.

1. In the written reply, the public body has taken the plea that the information required by the applicant falls under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, pertaining to the privacy of an individual; hence, it cannot be shared. The Commission has examined the contents of the information request.
2. It is noted that the applicant, vide his information request dated 12-12-2025 addressed to the designated officer of the public body, required a copy of the findings of an inquiry conducted against him, as the Inquiry Officer had issued him a notice dated 10-12-2024, copy of which is annexed with the information request.
3. Examining the said documents, the Commission has found that the inquiry, a copy of which is required by the applicant, pertains to himself and is not an inquiry report of a third person.
4. Under Section 5(i) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, it is provided that the principal officer of each public body shall, within six months of the commencement of this Act, ensure that the reports, including performance reports, audit reports, evaluation reports, inquiry or investigative reports, and other reports that have been finalized, are duly published, including uploading over the internet or in a manner which best ensures

that these are accessible, subject to reasonable restrictions based on limited resources.

5. Section 7(g) does not apply in this case, as stated above, because the inquiry report is in respect of an inquiry conducted against the applicant by the Inquiry Officer of the public body.
6. In view of the above, the appeal is allowed. Usman Ahmed Batt, Designated Officer, Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation, is directed to furnish the required information to the applicant as well as to this Commission within 10 days.
7. Adjourned to 07-04-2026 for implementation proceedings.
