None appeared on behalf of the applicant in spite of the fact that Ansar Mahmood Kiyani appeared on behalf of the applicant on 13-11-2025. On 26-11-2026, Mr. Hameed Hussain appeared on behalf of Ansar Mahmood Kiyani and sought another adjournment, which was granted.

1. On 27-11-2027, nobody appeared on behalf of the applicant, and a final opportunity was granted to the applicant for arguments, and the hearing was adjourned for today. But today, again, in spite of the issuance of two notices with the direction to ensure appearance today, otherwise an order shall be passed in accordance with law, nobody is present.
2. Service of the notice is also confirmed from the website of Pakistan Post.
3. In view of the above, the Commission decided to proceed as under:
4. The applicant has filed his information request dated 13-12-2024 to the Executive Director, Poly Clinic Islamabad, for sharing certain information in respect of entries of the injured and dead bodies in the hospital on certain dates.
5. Allegedly, the said information was not provided; hence, he filed this appeal.
6. The office, during the scrutiny of the information request and memo of the appeal, found that the appeal is inadmissible under section 11(1) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 as neither the information request nor the appeal was filed by the applicant as a citizen of Pakistan.
8. The Commission has examined the said objection and also provided reasonable opportunities to the applicant to justify his information request and appeal and assist the Commission in removing the said objection, either through appearance or through written arguments.

9. The Commission has noted that under section 11(1) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of this Act and the rules made thereunder, a citizen of Pakistan may make a request to a public body through the designated official.
10. Under Rule 4(1) of the Right of Access to Information Rules, any citizen of Pakistan or any person who is acting for or on behalf of such person may apply on plain paper or by using the sample application form, as may be prescribed by the Information Commission.
11. In the Act as well as under the Rules, it is quite clear that the Act only entitles a citizen of Pakistan to file an information request before the designated officer of a public body requiring certain information, but in the present case, the applicant has neither filed the information request nor the appeal as a citizen of Pakistan; rather, it has been filed as Chairman, Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf.
12. Under Article 19-A of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, it is provided that every citizen shall have the right to have access to information in all matters of public importance subject to regulation and reasonable restrictions imposed law.
13. In view of the above, this appeal is not maintainable and is inadmissible. No further proceedings are required. Copy of the order be sent to the applicant.

1. Background of this case is that after issuing two notices on the appeal, nobody appeared on behalf of the public body, and a final notice was issued to the Chairman, NHA for ensuring the appearance of a senior officer before the Commission, and proceedings were adjourned for 11-11-2025.
2. On the said date, Muhammad Waqas Saleem, Advocate, appeared on behalf of NHA, and on his request, adjournment was granted and the appeal was fixed for hearing on 03-12-2025.
3. On the said date, the above-named counsel, along with Muhammad Umar, Assistant, NHA, appeared before the Commission but did not file comments, nor was any information provided in spite of two adjournments granted on their request.
4. The Commission, taking notice of the said situation and taking into consideration that the appeal is to be disposed of within 60 days, issued a show cause notice to the Chairman, NHA under section 20(1)(f) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, and proceedings were adjourned to 01-01-2026.
5. On the said date, nobody appeared, and on telephonic contact, learned counsel for the public body furnished partial information with the further submission that the remaining information could be provided after deposit of the photocopying charges, and in view of the above, the applicant was asked to deposit the photocopying charges in order to obtain the remaining information.
6. However, reply to the show cause notice was not received, and a fresh notice was issued to the Chairman, NHA to show cause as to why a penalty may not be imposed and proceedings under Section 20(1)(f) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 may not be initiated against him for causing delay in provision of the information under the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.

7. The case was adjourned for today, but again today neither did anybody appear on behalf of the Chairman, NHA nor has any reply been received. Delivery of the said notice is also confirmed from the website of Pakistan Post.
8. Proceedings were adjourned for today requiring the Chairman, NHA to ensure the appearance of a senior representative of the public body, but neither reply of show cause notice is received nor anybody appeared on behalf of NHA.
9. In the given circumstances, the Commission has no option but to proceed further.
10. It is quite clear that delay in furnishing the information has been caused on behalf of the Chairman, NHA; the appeal remained pending from 15-10-2025 to 01-01-2026, whereafter some partial information was provided. Moreover, a reply to the show cause notice was not furnished by the Chairman, NHA in spite of being given multiple opportunities.
11. In view of the above, the Commission is left with no other option but to proceed against the Chairman, NHA. Hence, a fine equal to 15 days' salary of the Chairman, NHA is imposed under section 20(1)(f) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017. Member (Finance), NHA, is directed to deduct 15 days' salary of the Chairman, NHA and submit a compliance report before the Commission on the next date of hearing. A copy of the order be also sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Communications for implementation.

3. Now, the grievance of the applicant is that although he has filed an application for the reconstruction of the file to the CDA, the file has not been reconstructed.
4. The powers of the Pakistan Information Commission under the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 are in respect of obtaining information from public bodies regarding public records held by such public bodies. If reconstruction of the file has not been made by the CDA/public body, the applicant may approach the concerned forum to take action against the CDA on account of the non-reconstruction of the file.
