Gul Hasssan, Deputy Director, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The National Council for Tibb, vide letter dated 14-07-2025, provided list of the recognized Tibbia Colleges along with the names of the colleges and further submitted that the rest of the record of the colleges may be obtained from the Registrar Joint Stock of the concerned district.

2. It was further informed by the Registrar, National Council for Tibb, who appeared on 16-07-2025 and stated that the information cited at serial No. 2 of the information request cannot be provided as it pertains to private buildings of the private colleges and is exempted from disclosure under Section 7(h) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017. The Commission agreed with the Registrar, National Council for Tibb, and directed the Registrar's office to share the information furnished. The office shared the response of the public body with the applicant vide letter dated 17-07-2025, which the applicant acknowledged; however, the applicant filed rejoinder dated 27-08-2025, showing dissatisfaction over the provided information. The Commission has examined the contents of the information request, the written reply, and the rejoinder of the applicant.

3. As far as copies of the registration certificates along with renewal certificates for the year 2024 are concerned, the National Council for Tibb has categorically stated that it has provided a list of the colleges registered and that the registration certificates are not held by it but by the Registrar Joint Stock of the concerned district.

4. The information sought at serial No. 2 of the information request also cannot be provided under Section 7(h) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017, and the Commission has already passed an order in this regard.

5. In view of the above, after sharing the list of the registered Tibbia Colleges with the applicant, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
