It is noted that allegedly an amount of Rs. 525,230/- was fraudulently withdrawn from the account of the appellant and he filed complaint before the Federal Investigation Agency Cyber Crime Rawalpindi but no action has been taken yet, therefore, request is made to take action for the return of the said amount. Since the appellant did not require any information/document in his information request to the Director General Federal Investigation Agency, therefore, the appeal is not maintainable before this Commission. Syed Ahmed Iqbal, Section Officer, Ministry of Housing and Works appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body vide letter dated 18-3-25 furnished information in respect of 196 officers out of 201, which already stands shared with the appellant. For the remaining information, time was required, which was granted, and today the public body vide letter dated 28-4-25 has informed that it has been confirmed that all 201/201 allottees of Gulshan-e-Jinnah Suit are not availing any facility as mentioned in the information request of the appellant. It is further added that the said information relates to the personal privacy of the individuals and is exempted from disclosure under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
2. However, the question of exclusion does not arise as the required information does not relate to the privacy of any individual and the same has been furnished. Copy of the letter dated 28-4-25 furnished today be also shared with the appellant.
3. Since all the information required by the appellant stands shared with the appellant, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.

1. The public body vide letter dated 25-11-25 submitted that similar appeal bearing No. 3621-04/24 was filed by the appellant against the Ministry of Interior, and the Ministry in its reply informed that the inquiry in question has not been finalized by the competent authority, and the appeal was dismissed vide order dated 24-10-24.
2. Copy of the said reply was shared with the appellant, who has submitted that he has not been provided any information, and the Commission, while deciding the appeal, directed the Secretary, Ministry of Interior, to look into the matter and ensure that the inquiry should be concluded within the stipulated time period as directed by the Government of Pakistan from time to time.
3. After examining the information request, written reply, and rejoinder of the appellant, it is noted that the inquiry is still under process and has not yet been finalized. Therefore, the provision of Section 7(c) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 applies in this case. However, it is also noted that the order passed in the earlier appeal No. 3621-04/24 regarding concluding the inquiry has not yet been implemented.
4. Therefore, the appeal is disposed of with directions to the Secretary, Ministry of Interior, to ensure finalization of the inquiry within a period of one month, with intimation to this Commission. Copy of the order be sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Interior, and the appellant.
