1. The public body, vide written reply furnished today, has submitted that the appeal is misconceived, without legal basis, and liable to be dismissed as the information sought by the appellant pertains to matters that fall entirely outside the statutory mandate, jurisdiction, and regulatory domain of IHRA.

2. It is further added that the said information falls within the jurisdiction of the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council, HEC, and other statutory academic/accreditation bodies.

3. Lastly, it is submitted that the matter of the registration, evaluation, or inspection of HBS Medical and Dental College or any medical/dental college and the public body does not hold any of the information requested by the applicant.

4. The Commission has also examined the information request whereby the applicant has sought certain information which relates to the other public body mentioned in the written reply. When the IHRA has categorically stated that none of the information mentioned in the information request is held by them, hence, the appeal is not proceedable, hence The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order along with written reply be shared with the applicant. Copy of the order be also sent to the public body.

December 04, 2025 Gul Hassan Deputy Director, Ministry of Health Services, Regulations & Coordination appeared on behalf of the public body.

1. The public body vide letter dated 04-12-2025 has submitted written reply taking certain objections about the maintainability of the appeal, further stating that similar applications have already been received by the public body from Mr. Uzair Razzaq, Aysal Elham, and Mr. Zohaib Hussain (present applicant). Moreover, it is added that Mr. Uzair Razzaq is involved in various criminal FIRs related to an anti-state campaign against the state organization. In para 4 of the written reply, it is submitted that the documents required by the applicant are sensitive/official-classified in nature and cannot be disclosed without lawful justification. It is further submitted that none of the applicants has provided any legitimate grounds for seeking the required information. Lastly, it is submitted that the required information relates to personal information of certain officers and is exempted from disclosure under the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
2. The Commission has considered the plea of the public body taken in the written reply. As far as the allegations against the citizen seeking information from the public body are concerned, this Commission has no concern with these allegations. The Commission is mandated to share the information held by the public body which is neither classified nor non-disclosable under Sections 7 and 16 of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
3. The applicant has required a copy of the posting, promotion, re-designation, and cadre change orders of certain officers of the public body and has also required the reasons for failure to take action against illegally regularized officers despite clear directions of the Supreme Court, Law Division, and FPSC.
4. The applicant has also required a list of the sanctioned strength of the Ministry along with an updated organogram, duly authenticated by the

Establishment Division, and clarification under what legal authority five DGs are working in the Ministry when only three posts exist.

5. In addition to that, the applicant has also required certified educational degrees, professional qualifications, service records, and asset declarations and wealth statements of certain employees.
6. The Commission has found that except for the information required at Serial No. 3, 4, and 8 of the information request, all the information pertains to public record and does not enjoy any exemption from disclosure under the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017. However, information cited at Serial No. 3 and 4 of the information request pertains to the personal privacy of the individuals except the provision of record of educational qualifications, posting profile, and service record; hence, it cannot be shared with the applicant as provided under Section 7(g) of the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017.
7. In response to information cited at Serial No. 3 and 4, the applicant should be provided information about the qualifications and service records of the employees.
8. Information cited at Serial No. 8 cannot be provided as there is no data maintained by the public body showing how many qualified graduates and FPSC candidates have been deprived due to the unlawful retention of illegal appointees.
9. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties. Secretary, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination is directed to provide the required information in the manner mentioned above within 10 days to the applicant as well as to this Commission.
10. Adjourned to 07-01-2025 for implementation proceedings.
