None appeared on behalf of the public body. Information on the request of the appellant was originally provided to her vide letter dated 25-09-2024 under RGL No. 139878725. The appellant has stated that she had not received information from January 2024 to date, as well as information mentioned at Serial Nos. 3 and 4 of her information request. The public body was asked to provide further information, which was shared with the appellant vide letter dated 05-12-2024 under RGL No. 142238373. The public body has stated that the information relating to Serial Nos. 3 and 4 of the information request was Nil, whereas details w.e.f. January 2024 about prohibited bore and non-prohibited bore licenses were provided.

2. The appellant, vide her email dated 23-12-2024, has stated that the Ministry has provided her information, but it does not match the information she has received from her sources. She has attached a copy of the audit para, which shows variation regarding figures relating to FY 2022-2023. The appellant has requested the Commission to issue directions to the public body to look into this difference. She has also requested that in case the Commission decides to close this appeal, then her above-mentioned query may be cited in the order for the record.
3. It is now clear that the information provided by the public body has been shared with the appellant and is in accordance with her information request. The protocol is that the information provided under the signature of a responsible officer of the public body is to be treated as authentic unless proved otherwise. The copy of the audit para enclosed by the appellant is an issue under resolution between the public body and the audit office, and there is an established procedure for that.
4. The requirements of the appeal have been met. The observation of the appellant has been incorporated into the order. A copy of

the email along with the audit report sent by the appellant is forwarded to the Secretary, Ministry of Interior, for resolution in accordance with the audit procedures.

5. In view of the above-mentioned position, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
