Malik Mazhar, AO, Explosive (Petroleum Division) and Hafeezullah, Deputy Director, present on behalf of public body.

2. The public body vide letter 23-12-2024 has forwarded response received from explosive department it is submitted that most information desired by the appellant cannot be shared to any individual which pertains to the privacy of private business, it is further added that excessive data from manual record will involve heavy expenditure as photocopies of more than 100,000 (One Hundred Thousand) pages are involve in this case. Moreover, due to shortage of manpower, it is submitted that period of 8 months' is required for collecting of the same information.

3. The response of the public body is not objective. Public body has not pointed that which information pertains to privacy of private business and under what provision of Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 it enjoys the exemption from disclosure. Moreover, time required for collection of said information is unreasonable as the Commission has to disposed of the appeal within the specific period of 60 days. In this digital era now, everything is digitalized and computerized and data can collect within the span of short time. Therefore, it is directed that an objection be furnished pointing out specific information exemption from disclosure under the specific provision of Right of Access to Information Act, 2017 and reasonable time and expenditure involves for sharing the information which is not exempted.
