1. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the public body has furnished a reply to the rejoinder. It is submitted that the public body has no objection to sharing information cited at Serial Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, 26, 27, 29, 30, and 32, subject to payment of photocopying fees as per the Access to Information (Fee) Regulations, 2023. However, the remaining information does not pertain to the public body, and some of it contains personal information of individuals.

2. The Commission has heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the public body, perused the information request, rejoinder of the applicant, and the reply thereto, and has found that the public body shall share the audit report cited at Serial No. 5 of the information request, being a public document, which contains audit paras, replies to the same, and their settlement.

3. It is further noted that the list of employees cited at Serial No. 12 of the information request, who resigned from project service, be provided — except copies of their resignation letters and the approval of the competent authority. Similarly, regarding the information referred to at Serial No. 14 of the information request, relating to the total bank account details of the project and balances as of date, it will be appropriate if the public body provides the total number of accounts along with their opening and closing balances.

4. As far as the minutes of meetings referred to at various points in the information request are concerned, it was admitted during the arguments that the said minutes are finalized. However, the counsel expressed reservations that the personal particulars of individuals reflecting negative remarks pertain to their personal records. The Commission agrees to this extent and concludes that the minutes of the recruitment committee be shared with the Commission as well as the

applicant, except for any negative remarks recorded by the selection committee.

5. The appeal is allowed in the manner that the Deputy Secretary (D-II) / Public Information Officer, Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), shall furnish the record/information as mentioned above within 10 days of the payment of the photocopying fee and submission of the deposit slip to the Commission or the public body.
