1. The public body, vide letter dated 25-08-2025, furnished answers to all the queries of the applicant along with copies of the relevant documents, and copy of the said response was shared with the applicant.

2. The applicant has received the said information but has filed detailed rejoinder dated 12-9-2025. The Commission has examined the contents of the information request, the written reply of the public body, and the dissatisfaction/grievance note of the applicant. It has noted that the public body has categorically answered each query of the applicant, adequately addressing the queries of the applicant.

3. Now, the applicant has sought further information in respect of most of the queries which are beyond the scope of the information request. Moreover, the details of the expenditure in query No. 49 of the information request, in respect of boring, have again been requested by the applicant, despite the fact that the public body has stated that no boring has been carried out at the Visitors Facilitation Centre, Kaliyar.

4. The Commission has noted that all the queries of the information request have been properly answered by the public body in a categorical manner; therefore, the queries now put forth by the applicant in his rejoinder are found to be beyond the scope of the information request and hence cannot be entertained.

5. In view of the above, no further proceedings are required. The appeal stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to both the parties.
